Re: Letter of Recommendation

Dear Mike:

I would like to thank you and the crew members of Associate Roofing for the high quality and timely work performed in re-roofing my saltbox colonial home in Hingham.

The re-roofing involved installation of 5/8" thick premium red cedar shakes after removal of the old shingles, cutting open the roof to install a peak ventilation system; closing; application of ice and water shields; installation of the underlayment followed by installation of the Cedar Breather for ventilation and long life of the entire cedar shake roof.

As this work was done in late November, following Thanksgiving and between two rainstorms, I am particularly appreciative of both the crew size you applied to this job as well as the enthusiasm and good cheer with which the work was carried out.

The work was performed, the property cleaned up and the dumpster removed in a 2-day span of time. This is particularly noteworthy, as I have observed other homes of comparable size draped in blue tarps for one to three weeks as the roofing work proceeds. Such an approach would have exposed our home to the risk of interior water damage under the weather conditions of the time.
